CONSTRUCTION ON OR ADJACENT TO COUNCIL ROAD RESERVE

When constructing on or near roadways or footpaths it is important to follow work health and safety guidelines to improve the safety of the general public as well as employees, it is also important to follow regulations as set out by the Roads Act 1993.

Leeton Shire has an S138 application form for permission to carry out these works in the road reserve. This application requires the submission of a scope of works plan, a traffic control plan, and appropriate public liability documentation. Without this approval all liability is the responsibility of the person carrying out the works if injury or damage occurs to persons or property.

Having a Traffic Control Plan with appropriate signage to warn and direct motorists and pedestrians around or through the worksite is legislated for this reason.

Not complying with Traffic Control is enforceable by WorkCover NSW through Penalty Notices and Enforceable undertakings.

WorkCover NSW have a rebate program which may be used to cover the purchase of safety equipment including signage and traffic cones for small businesses.
