PROPOSED ROAD CLOSING/LEASE

Under Section 35 of the Roads Act 1993, notice is given that the Minister for Natural Resources, Land and Water will consider the closing of a road in connection with a road closing application proposed by Council. The road is also proposed to be leased until the road is closed.

Council (acting on behalf of the Minister) will receive submissions regarding the proposal. All submissions received will be referred to the Minister's delegate for a decision regarding the proposed road closing.

The road under consideration comprises Council unnamed public road reserve adjoining Lots 710, 714, 715 & 716 of DP 751745 and Lot 1 of DP 1190127 (road intersecting Railway Avenue, Leeton and running into CopRice).

All interested persons are invited to make submissions concerning the proposal to the General Manager, Leeton Shire Council, 23-25 Chelmsford Place, Leeton NSW 2705, within twenty-eight (28) days, by close of business on 16 June 2017.

Regarding the provisions of the Government Information (Public Access) Act, information contained in such submissions may, at the discretion of Leeton Shire Council and NSW Trade and Investment (Crown Lands), be referred to the person(s) who initiated the proposal for appropriate consideration.
