



ROXY REDEVELOPMENT COMMUNITY CONSULTATION SESSIONS



Council is off to an exciting start after being allocated \$3.9 million for the refurbishment of Leeton's historic Roxy Theatre through round two of the NSW Government's \$100 million Regional Cultural Fund.

While the current concept plans were developed after significant consultation with user groups, it is now appropriate to consult further before locking in the final designs.

Council invites you to register to participate in one of two community consultation sessions to be held on Thursday 21st February 2019 at the Roxy Community Theatre. Currently there are two sessions available 2pm to 4pm and 5.30pm to 7.30pm to be held at the Roxy Theatre. Each session is capped at 50 members of the community and should there be more interest in these sessions an additional timeslot will be added. Community and Council leaders along with two professional experts will lead these sessions.

The community workshops will provide residents and community groups with a strong interest in the Roxy's future the opportunity to participate intensively in the technical and operational issues and proposals including but not limited to:

- Firming up a vision that will ensure The Roxy is enjoyed by future generations
- Understanding the restoration process
- Optimising seating numbers
- Optimising back of house requirements
- Ensuring appropriate Disability Access
- Ensuring affordable operational costs for both community and Council
- Prioritising theatre equipment improvements
- Seeking input from Leeton café operators on best way to deliver functions and food services to patrons without impacting Leeton retail commercial activity.
- Understanding what is required for successful project delivery.

Both individuals and group representatives who are deeply interested in how their Roxy Theatre will look and function and how arts and culture will be developed in Leeton over the next 50 years are critical to the success of this consultation phase.
