



## DRAFT 2018/19 ANNUAL OPERATIONAL PLAN AND FEES AND CHARGES

Leeton Shire Council now has on public exhibition for your consideration the draft Annual Operational Plan, draft Budget, draft Revenue Policy and draft Fees and Charges for 2018/19. This is year 2 of Council's 4-year Delivery Program (2017-2021).

Council's operational budget for 2018/19 is steady but its capital works budget is significantly increased as we have access to several grants from the State Government. The total cost of all capital works, a mix of new and upgrades, is \$21.2 million. Council is proposing to borrow \$1 million in order to make some of the works happen.

To find additional revenue, Council has also reviewed its fees and charges for 2018/19 to ensure direct recipients of services are paying a fairer share towards the costs of the services they use (with opportunities for subsidies where appropriate).
