Leeton Shire Council's Local Heritage Fund assists owners and/or lessees of significant land/or heritage building with funding for projects. Grants from a total pool of \$50,000 are available for projects that enhance or restore building facades, or signage.

Applications are available for work projects involving repair/replacement of heritage façade details, painting external facades, mandatory Building Code of Australia (BCA) works and installation of sympathetic advertising signage.

EXPRESSIONS OF INTEREST TO MANAGE THE CONFIRM ASSET MANAGEMENT IMPLEMENTATION

Council seeks Expressions of Interest (EOI) from parties to manage the Confirm Asset Management Implementation. EOIs should include; an hourly rate for 250 hours of project management with an option to extend and previous experience with Asset Management Systems.

Key deliverables expected from the project are:

- Meet policy and legislative requirements, especially for reporting on infrastructure asset condition, serviceability and safety.
- Contain cost and liability from risk exposures.
- Improve the medium and long-term sustainability of the asset portfolios.
- Improve capability for strategic and tactical investment planning and immediate service delivery.
- Delivery of monthly/annual depreciation across asset classes.
