Failure to pay the Fourth Instalment by the due date renders it overdue and subject to the addition of interest charges at a rate of 7.5 percent per annum, calculated daily.

Payment may be made on the Internet ([www.leeton.nsw.gov.au](http://www.leeton.nsw.gov.au)) by credit card by clicking on the option to pay online. B-Pay is also available (Bill Code No. 303321). Payment can also be made at any Australia Post agency or Commonwealth Bank branch by presenting your intact notice. To pay by telephone with MasterCard or Visa, please call 1300 276 468 anytime.

Please note that if payments are made by post, ensure sufficient time is allowed for the payment to reach Council on or before the due date.

### PRIVATE SWIMMING POOL AND ONSITE SEWERAGE SYSTEM INSPECTIONS

Residents and ratepayers of Leeton Shire are reminded that Council has statutory obligations to undertake swimming pool and onsite sewerage systems inspections.

Council wishes to inform you that Council is now commencing to implement this inspection program.

Inspections will be carried out on a quarterly basis and all residents and ratepayers will receive notification in writing prior to an inspection taking place.

Council is aiming to inspect 50 swimming pools and 50 on site sewerage systems per year.
