



WORKS ON OR ADJACENT TO COUNCIL ROAD RESERVE

When performing works on or near roadways or footpaths it is important to follow work health and safety guidelines to improve the safety of the general public as well as employees, it is also important to follow regulations as set out by the Roads Act.

Works within the road reserve may include activities like erecting a structure, digging up or disturbing the surface of a public road (or footpath) to construct a driveway, removing, interfering or temporary erection of a structure, blocking off marked carparks for vehicle parking, or any other activities as defined within the Roads Act.

Leeton Shire has an application form (\$138) for permission to carry out works in the road reserve. This requires documentation including, a traffic control plan and appropriate public liability. Without this approval, all liability is the responsibility of the person carrying out the works if injury or damage occurs to persons or property. There are also several notices and infringements that can be issued under the Local Government Act & Roads Act.

Not complying with the requirement for approval to work within the road could lead to issuing of a stop work order by Council officials, and various notices and infringements issued under the Local Government Act & Roads Act. For further information or applications forms please contact Council.

The regular location of the taxi zone on Wade Avenue will revert to a Loading Zone and No Parking zone to allow families with competitors to drop off equipment required for their performances and to facilitate the safe pick up and drop off of students at the Roxy Theatre during the Eisteddfod.

Please note that vehicles cannot be parked in this area and rangers will be patrolling the zone to ensure it is used properly.
