



LOCAL HERITAGE GRANTS 2018-2019

FUNDING NOW AVAILABLE FOR HERITAGE PROJECTS

Leeton Shire Council's Local Heritage Fund assists owners and/or lessees of significant land/or heritage building with funding for projects. Grants from a total pool of \$50,000 are available for projects that enhance or restore building facades, or signage.

Applications are available for work projects involving repair/replacement of heritage façade details, painting external facades, mandatory Building Code of Australia (BCA) works and installation of sympathetic advertising signage.

Selection Criteria:

- Public benefit
- Sustainable long term heritage benefits
- Public benefit and enjoyment
- Alignment with Council Priorities
- Capacity and commitment to undertake the project
- Value for money and cost effectiveness

PRIVATE SWIMMING POOL AND ONSITE SEWERAGE SYSTEM INSPECTIONS

Council has statutory obligations to undertake swimming pool and on site sewerage systems inspections which will be carried out in the near future.

Inspections will be carried out on a quarterly basis and all residents and ratepayers whose properties will be inspected will receive prior notification in writing to arrange for an inspection to take place.

We are aiming to inspect 50 swimming pools and 50 on site sewerage systems per year.
