## PRIVATE SWIMMING POOL AND ONSITE SEWERAGE SYSTEM INSPECTIONS.

Residents and ratepayers of Leeton Shire are reminded that Council has statutory obligations to undertake swimming pool and on site sewerage systems inspections.

Council wishes to inform you that Council is now commencing to implement this inspection program.

Inspections will be carried out on a quarterly basis and all residents and ratepayers will receive notification in writing prior to an inspection taking place.

Council is aiming to inspect 50 swimming pools and 50 on site sewerage systems per year.

## PREVENTING WEEDS PROTECTS OUR AGRICULTURAL WAY OF LIFE

When you bring feed and fodder from outside NSW onto your property, you risk introducing new weeds. Some weeds are considered the most serious biosecurity threats to NSW that could be found in feed and fodder from other parts of Australia. Keep an eye out for these, but most importantly:

- Check your feed out areas regularly for any new or unusual plants and call your local council weeds officer for assistance if you find anything.
- Some weeds don't occur in NSW and are known as Prohibited Matter under the Biosecurity Act. They must be reported so that the authorities can act quickly to stop their spread.
- Some are serious weeds that do occur in parts of NSW but must not be imported into the state or carried into certain regions of NSW.
