Leeton Shire Council advises all ratepayers that the third and final Water Usage account for the 2016/2017 financial year is due **Friday 16 June 2017**.

Failure to pay the Water Usage account by the due date renders it overdue and subject to the addition of interest charges of 8 percent per annum calculated daily.

Payment may be made on the Internet (www.leeton.nsw.gov.au) by credit card by clicking on the option to pay online. B-Pay is also available (Biller Code No. 303321). Payment can also be made at any Australia Post agency or Commonwealth Bank branch by presenting your intact notice. To pay by telephone with MasterCard or Visa, telephone 1300 276 468 anytime.

Please note that if payments are made by post, ensure sufficient time is allowed for the payment to reach Council on or before the due date.

CONSTRUCTION ON OR ADJACENT TO COUNCIL ROAD RESERVE

When constructing on or near roadways or footpaths it is important to follow work health and safety guidelines to improve the safety of the general public as well as employees, it is also important to follow regulations as set out by the Roads Act 1993.

Leeton Shire has an application form for permission to carry out works in the road Reserve which requires a traffic control plan and appropriate public liability documentation. Without this approval all liability is the responsibility of the person carrying out the works if injury or damage occurs to persons or property.

Having a Traffic Control Plan with appropriate signage to warn and direct motorists and pedestrians around or through the worksite is recommended for this reason.

Not complying with Traffic Control is enforceable by Work Cover NSW through Penalty Notices and Enforceable undertakings.

Work Cover NSW have a rebate program which may be used to cover the purchase of safety equipment including signage and traffic cones for small businesses.
