= Shire = Overview

Leeton Shire is a local government area in the Western Riverina region of New South Wales. Around 1,167 square kilometres in size, Leeton Shire includes the towns of Leeton, Yanco and Whitton and the villages of Murrami and Wamoon.

The Western Riverina region enjoys a semi-arid climate with hot dry summers and cool winters. The maximum average summer temperature is 32 degrees Celsius and the maximum average winter temperature is 15 degrees Celsius. The average annual rainfall is 457 millimetres.


Leeton Shire is well connected and easily accessible by air, coach, rail and road to regional centres and capital cities. The distance to Sydney is 584 kilometres; to Melbourne is 470 kilometres; to Canberra is 371 kilometres; and to Wagga Wagga is 125 kilometres. Located adjacent to the Murrumbidgee River, the Leeton Shire is also the centre of the Murrumbidgee Irrigation Area (MIA). The MIA was purposely built over one hundred years ago as part of the Murrumbidgee Irrigation Scheme through the extraordinary vision and hard work of pioneers and governments. The irrigation scheme was designed to drought proof inland Australia and provide national food security.


Today the MIA is one of the most diverse and productive regions in Australia and the heart of Australia's food bowl. Citrus, grapes, grains, nuts, vegetable, livestock, cotton farms and other crops are found abundantly throughout the area, playing a significant role in feeding and clothing people from around the nation and the globe.


The town of Leeton was designed by Sir Walter Burley Griffin who also designed Canberra, the nation's capital. Thirty-five buildings in the Leeton Shire are listed with the Australian Institute of Architects' Register of Significant 20th Century Buildings, including the landmark Roxy Community Theatre.

The heritage-listed art deco Roxy Community Theatre is an iconic building steeped in history. Located in Leeton's Pine Avenue, the stylish 'Roxy' offers regular movie screenings, events, live theatre shows and concerts. Many of the Shire's buildings were influenced by the art deco style of the 1920's to the 1940's. Examples of features found commonly on buildings are mosaic tiling in recessed doorways, decorative vertical tile designs at shopfronts, pressed metal awning on ceilings, thinly framed glazed windows, stepped rendered parapets at upper facades, rendered vertical piers and facades with feature chevron brickwork.

Community art and cultural events are regularly celebrated throughout the year and include the Australian Art Deco Festival Leeton, Leeton Eisteddfod, Penny Paniz Memorial Arts Acquisitive Competition, NAIDOC Week, Harmony Day and many more. For more information visit

SWIMMING

The sunny days of the region's warmer months make swimming an attractive activity. Leeton Shire has two outdoor swimming pools. These hubs are for people of all ages and abilities to exercise and socialise. Swimming classes are also available. The pools are open during the warmer months and close for the winter period.

Leeton Regional Aquatic Centre features a state-of-the-art 10 lane 50 metre Olympic swimming pool, learn to swim area with splash pool, kiosk, change rooms and disability access. Spacious lawn areas and barbeque facilities are also available. The Whitton Swimming Pool complex is a hidden delight, offering swimmers a 25 metre pool with 6 lanes, a shaded toddler pool and change rooms. CYCLING PATHS

Animal owners are responsible to ensure their pets are healthy, safe and do not create disturbances in the neighbourhood. It is also mandatory under the Companion Animals Act that pet owners ensure their cats and dogs are microchipped for identification and registered with their local Council.

In NSW, all cats and dogs, other than exempt cats and dogs, must be microchipped by 12 weeks of age or before being sold or given away, whichever happens first. Council provides subsidised microchipping services.

All cats and dogs, other than exempt cats and dogs, must be registered by six months of age. The registration fee is a once-only payment, which covers the cat or dog for its lifetime in NSW, regardless of any changes in ownership. You can register your pet in the following ways:

- Online at NSW Pet Registry www.petregistry.nsw.gov.au.
- Over the counter at Leeton Shire Council.
- Over the counter and online at Service NSW www.service.nsw.gov.au.
